ELIGIBILITY: The VST Test is for dogs that have earned the TD or TDX title.

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 per VST entrant.

CLOSING DATE: 6:00 PM Wednesday, July 29, 2009, at the Test Secretary's home after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted.

A DRAWING for entry numbers will be held on Wednesday, July, 29, 2009, at 8:00 PM at the Test Secretary's home. This test is open to all breeds. The drawing for VST entries will be conducted as follows, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 13, of the AKC Tracking Regulations Amended to June 1, 2005:

After the entry limit is reached, an alternate list will be prepared with positions assigned according to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entries of the results of the draw via e-mail only. After July 29th, entrants may call the Test Secretary until 9:00 PM concerning the results of the drawing.

ALTERNATES: If an alternate track is plotted and laid, it will be at the judges' discretion to determine whether or not it will be available as a titling track.

WITHDRAWALS: If an entry withdraws for any reason between the closing date and the test date, and is replaced by an alternate, the entry fee will be refunded. The entry fee for an alternate who does not participate will be refunded within seven days after the test. Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Test Secretary.

REFUNDS: If you are not selected in the draw or elect to withdraw, and would like your entry returned, please enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope. Otherwise, all such entries and checks will be destroyed.

BITCHES IN SEASON will be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches have been tested. They will be allowed on the tracking grounds only immediately prior to the running of their tracks. Please notify the Test Secretary as soon as you know your bitch is in season for this test.

TROPHIES: The Yankee Golden Retriever Club will offer a rosette and photo frame to all passing Variable Surface Tracking teams.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST HEADQUARTERS

Demeritt Hill Farm, 66 Lee Road, Lee NH

FROM THE NORTH & SOUTH: From I-95 take exit 4, Spaulding Turnpike, Routes 4 West and 16 North (left exit from the south). Just before the Dover toll booth, take exit #6W Route 4 West towards Durham and Concord. There are three Durham exits (the second exit is a light at Madbury Rd). Take the last exit, Route 155A UNH, Durham, and turn right at the bottom of the ramp onto 155A west. Continue straight to the stop sign which is the intersection of Routes 155A and 155. Turn right on Route 155 towards Dover. Go about a quarter mile to the Test Headquarters at Demeritt Hill Farm on the right.

FROM THE MANCHESTER NH AREA: Take NH-101 East to exit 7, RT-125. Follow NH-125 North to the traffic rotary and take the first exit onto US-4 East. Take the RT-155A exit onto 155A west and continue as above.

Note: A limited number of vehicles are allowed on campus during the test and we will be carpooling. Please leave unentered dogs at home.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
